A LAW TO AMEND THE IMMIGRATION LAW

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Law, 1994.

Amendment to the Immigration Law (Law 13 of 1992).

- 2. The Immigration Law is amended -
 - (a) by inserting at the beginning of section 47(1) the words "Subject to paragraph (4),";
 - (b) by adding the following paragraph at the end of section 47 -
 - "(4) (a) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any person or category of persons specified in regulations as being exempt from the requirements of that paragraph; and

- (b) the duty of the Chief Immigration Officer under paragraph (2) shall not apply in respect of any person or category of persons so exempted."; and
- (c) by adding at the end of section 71(2) the following paragraph -
 - "(f) prescribing the persons or categories of persons who are exempt from the requirements of section 47(1) of this Law.".

Passed by the Legislative Assembly the 9th day of March, 1994.
