## THE IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2004

The Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 38(1) and 93 of the Immigration Law, 2003 makes the following Regulations:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 2004.

Citation, commencement and expiry

- (2) These Regulations shall come into operation on  $4^{th}$  November, 2004 and shall cease to have effect upon the expiration of the period ending  $15^{th}$  December, 2004, unless the Governor extends the period by notice.
- 2. Personnel of the Caribbean Utilities Company who are directly engaged in the electricity restoration exercise occasioned by the damage to the electricity infrastructure of the Islands, caused by the recent hurricane, are exempt from the requirement to obtain a work permit.
