THE IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2012

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 99 of the Immigration Law (2011 Revision), the Governor in Cabinet makes the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 2012. Citation

2. The Immigration Regulations (2010 Revision) are amended in the First Schedule as follows - Amendment of the First
Schedule to the
Immigration Regulations
(2010 Revision) - fees

- (a) in Part 2 by inserting after the words “For Persons Employed in Grand Cayman, Cayman Brac and Little Cayman” the words “(except in the case of a person employed by the developer of the special economic zone known as Cayman Enterprise City or by a special economic zone enterprise carrying on special economic zone business in the special economic zone known as Cayman Enterprise City to which Part 2A applies)”; and
- (b) by inserting after Part 2, the following Part -

“PART 2A

The developer of the special economic zone known as Cayman Enterprise City or a special economic zone enterprise carrying on special economic zone business in the special economic zone known as Cayman Enterprise City shall in respect of an employee -

- (a) be exempt from the payment of the annual work permit fees specified in Part 2 including application fees, fees for variation of a work permit and fees in respect of dependants of the employee; and
- (b) pay an annual work permit fee of \$1230.00.”.
