A LAW to Amend the Immigration (Restriction)

BE it enacted by the Assembly of Justices and Vestry of
the Cayman Islands as follows:—

1—This Law may be cited as the Immigration (Restriction) (Amendment) Law, 1944, and shall be read and construed as one with the Immigration (Restriction) Law, 1941, hereinafter referred to as the principal Law.
