A LAW to Amend the Immigration (Restriction) Law, 1941

BE it enacted by the Assembly of Justices and Vestry of the Cayman Islands as follows:-

1—This Law may be cited as the Immigration (Restriction) (Amendment) Law, 1944, and shall be read and construed as one with the Immigration (Restriction) Law, Law 9 of 1941. 1941, hereinafter referred to as the principal Law.
