CAYMAN ISLANDS

THE IMMIGRATION RESTRICTION (BRITISH SUBJECTS) REGULATIONS, 1969

(CAP. 67)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator in Council by section 34 (a) & (b) of the Immigration Restriction (British Subjects) Law, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration Restriction (British Subjects) Regulations, 1969 and shall come into operation on the 3rd day of February, 1969.

Short title and commencement.

2. Whenever steps are necessary to prevent the entrance of a prohibited immigrant into the Cayman Islands the Chief Immigration Officer shall:-

Prevention of entrance of prohibited immigrant.

- (a) publish by public notice in the form as set out in the Schedule hereto an order preventing prohibited immigrant and
- (b) immediately after such publication, circulate a copy of such order to every Shipping Agent and Airline operating in the Islands.
