A LAW TO AMEND THE INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY LAW (2017 REVISION) TO ENSURE THAT THE LAW IS SUBJECT TO THE PUBLIC AUTHORITIES LAW, 2017; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Information and Communications Technology (Amendment) Law, 2018.

Short title

2. The Information and Communications Technology Law (2017 Revision) is amended by repealing section 100 and substituting the following section -

Repeal and substitution of section 100 of the Information and Communications Technology Law (2017 Revision) - conflict of laws

“Conflict with other laws 100. (1) Where there is any inconsistency between this Law and any other Law, this Law shall prevail to the extent of the inconsistency, subject to subsection (2).

(2) Where there is any inconsistency between this Law and the Public Authorities Law, 2017, the Public Authorities Law shall prevail to the extent of any inconsistency.”
