In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 15 of the Insurance Law, 1979, and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, the following Regulations are hereby made -

Citation and commencement. Law 24 of 1979

CAYMAN ISLANDS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Insurance (Forms) Regulations, 1980, and shall come into operation on the date upon which the Insurance Law, 1979, comes into operation.

Interpretation

- 2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires -
  - "Law" means the Insurance Law, 1979;

Financial statement Fourth Schedule. 6. The financial statement under section 7 (4) shall be in the form set out in the Fourth Schedule.
