**A LAW TO AMEND THE LABOUR LAW (2001 REVISION) TO VARY
THE COMPOSITION OF THE APPEALS TRIBUNAL; AND FOR
INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Labour (Amendment) Law, 2006. Short title
2. The Labour Law (2001 Revision) is amended in section 77 as follows: Amendment of the
Labour Law (2001
Revision)-Establishment
of Appeals Tribunal
 - (a) in subsection (1) by deleting the word “four” and substituting the word “eight”; and
 - (b) by repealing subsection (3) and substituting the following:

“(3) The Governor may appoint two of the eight other members of the Appeals Tribunal to be Deputy Chairmen, either of whom is authorised to perform all the functions of the Chairman in relation to the hearing of appeals.”.
