| Citation | 1. These regulations may be cited as the Labour (Time Variation) Regulations 1992. |
| Section 67 varied | 2. The time periods established by sections 67(1) and (2) of the Law are varied as follows – <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) in subsection (1) the time period of seven days is varied to thirty days; and(b) in subsection (2) the time period of twenty-one days from receipt of the complaint is varied to at least twenty-one days after a notification has been given under subsection (1). |
