The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 73, 76 and 84 of the Labour Law (1996 Revision) makes the following Regulations-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Labour (Tribunal Members' Remuneration) Regulations, 1998.

Citation

2. The Chairmen and members of the Appeals Tribunal and of the Labour Tribunals established under sections 73 and 76 of the Labour Law (1996 Revision) shall receive the remuneration specified in the Schedule for each day, or part of a day, that they attend a meeting of the Appeals Tribunal or a Labour Tribunal.

3. The Labour (Board and Tribunal Members' Remuneration) Regulations, 1997 are repealed.
