**A LAW TO AMEND THE LIQUOR LICENSING LAW (1996 Revision)**

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Bill may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) (New Licences) Bill, 1999. Short title

2. The Liquor Licensing Law (1996 Revision) is amended in section 9-

(a) by repealing subsection (1A) and substituting the following-

Amendment of section 9  
of the Liquor Licensing  
Law (1995 Revision).

“(1A) A Board shall not grant any new licence in the Islands from 9 October 1998 or from such other date or dates as may be appointed by order of the Governor and published in the Gazette until such date or dates as may be appointed by order of the Governor and published in the Gazette and different dates may be appointed in relation to different categories of licences.”; and

- (b) by inserting in subsection (1B) the following new paragraph after paragraph (c)-  
“(d) hotel licences.”.
