

Amendment of section  
11 - appeals

4. Section 11 of the principal Law is amended-

- (a) by repealing the words "but an appeal shall lie from such refusal to the Governor in Council, and the Board shall inform the applicant of its right of appeal";
- (b) by inserting the following subsection-

"(1A) The provisions of sections 8A, 8B and 8C of the Trade and Business Licensing Law (1996 Revision) shall, with any necessary adjustments, apply to appeals from decisions of the Board under this Law."; and

- (c) in subsection (2), by repealing "A licence shall be issued for such duration, not being less than twelve years" and substituting "A licence may not be issued for a duration longer than twelve years without the consent of the Governor".

Amendment of section  
28 - confidentiality

5. Section 28 of the principal Law is amended in subsection (1) by the repeal of the reference to section 7(1) of the Immigration Law and the substitution of a reference to section 7 of that Law.

A LAW TO AMEND THE LOCAL COMPANIES (CONTROL) LAW (1995  
REVISION); TO TRANSFER RESPONSIBILITY FOR LICENSING TO A  
NEW BOARD; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Local Companies (Control) (Amendment) (Licensing) Law, 1997, and shall come into force on such date as may be appointed by Order by the Governor in Council, and different dates may be appointed for different provisions of this Law and in relation to different cases.
- 2. In this Law the Local Companies (Control) Law (1995 Revision) is referred to as “the principal Law”.
- 3. Section 2 of the principal Law is amended-
  - (a) by repealing the definition of “Board” and substituting the following definition-

“Board” means the board established by section 3A of the Trade and Business (Licensing) Law (1996 Revision);”;
  - (b) in the definition of “local company” by repealing the word “so”.
