REGULATIONS, 2003**

In accordance with the powers conferred by section 19 and 29 of the Marine Conservation law (2003 Revision) the Governor makes the following regulations-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Marine Conservation (Fishing Licences) Regulations. Citation

2. (1) An application for a monthly and an annual fishing licence shall be in Form A and Form B in the Schedule respectively. Forms
