THE MARINE CONSERVATION (FISHING LICENCES) REGULATIONS, 2003

In accordance with the powers conferred by section 19 and 29 of the Marine Conservation law (2003 Revision) the Governor makes the following regulations-

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Marine Conservation (Fishing Citation Licences) Regulations.
- 2. (1) An application for a monthly and an annual fishing licence shall be in Forms Form A and Form B in the Schedule respectively.
- (2) The monthly and annual fishing licence referred to in section 19 (3) of the Marine Conservation Law (2003 Revision) are set out in Form B and Form C of the Schedule respectively.
