THE MARINE CONSERVATION (GROUPER SPAWNING AREAS) NOTICE, 2011

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 and 6(8) of the Marine Conservation Law (2003 Revision), the Marine Conservation Board gives notice that it has issued the following directives –

- 1. This Notice may be cited as the Marine Conservation (Grouper Spawning Areas) Notice, 2011.
- 2. (1) The operation of 6(7) of the law is suspended in each designated grouper spawning area for a period of eight years from the date of commencement of this Notice.
 - (2) During the months of November through March in the eight year period_beginning on the date of commencement of this Notice, any person who, by any means, takes from a designated grouper spawning area or receives or has in his possession any Nassau grouper which has been taken from such an area contravenes the Law; and, in the months during which a person is permitted to take Nassau groupers from a designated spawning area, any person who, in any one day, causes or permits to be loaded onto any vessel in Cayman waters more than twelve groupers contravenes the law.
 - (3) In this paragraph, "designated grouper spawning area" means an area specified in the First Schedule to the restricted Marine Areas (Designation) Regulations (2003) Revision).
- 3. The Marine Conservation (Grouper Spawning Areas) Directives 2007 are revoked.
