A LAW TO AMEND THE MERCHANT SHIPPING LAW (2011 REVISION) TO MAKE SHIP REGISTRATION FEES PAYABLE TO THE MARITIME AUTHORITY RATHER THAN TO THE TREASURY; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED MATTERS

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Amendment) Law, 2014.
2. The Merchant Shipping Law (2011 Revision) is amended in section 462 (1) by repealing paragraph (a).
