## A LAW TO AMEND THE MOSQUITO (RESEARCH AND CONTROL) LAW (1998 REVISION); AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Mosquito (Research and Control) (Amendment) Law, 2006.

Short title

2. The Mosquito (Research and Control) Law (1998 Revision), in this Law referred to as "the principal Law", is amended in section 2 by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical placing of the following -

Amendment of section 2 of the Mosquito (Research and Control) Law (1998 Revision) -Definitions

- "ship" means a yacht, speed boat and every other description of vessel used in navigation, not exclusively propelled by oars;".
- 3. The Mosquito (Research and Control) Law (1998 Revision) is amended in section 25 -

Amendment of section 25 - Disinsection of aircraft and ships

(a) in subsection (1) by deleting "shall be disinsected" and substituting therefor "may, in the discretion of the Director or such other person as may be generally or specifically authorised by him in that behalf, be disinsected";

- (b) by adding the following -
  - "(4) For the purposes of this section, reference to an aircraft or ship includes containers, motor vehicles and other things aboard an aircraft or ship.".

Validation

- 4. (1) The charging and collection of fees (in respect of any disinsection of aircraft and ships) prior to the date of commencement of this Law, in purported exercise of powers conferred by the Mosquito (Research and Control) Law (1998 Revision), is validated and is to be taken to have been lawfully charged and collected.
- (2) This Law does not affect any order or determination made by a court before the coming into force of this Law.
- (3) If any proceeding for an offence committed before the coming into force of this Law -
  - (a) was commenced but not finally determined before that time; or
  - (b) is commenced on or after that time,

the proceeding is to be dealt with and determined as if this Law had not been enacted.
