**A LAW TO AMEND THE NATIONAL DRUG COUNCIL LAW (2003  
REVISION) AS A CONSEQUENCE OF THE CREATION OF THE  
CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICE OF MINISTER CHARGED WITH  
RESPONSIBILITY FOR FINANCE; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR  
INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED MATTERS**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the National Drug Council (Amendment) Law, 2010.

Short title

2. The National Drug Council Law (2003 Revision) is amended in sections 6 and 26 by deleting the words “Financial Secretary” wherever they appear and substituting the words “member of the Cabinet charged with responsibility for finance”.
