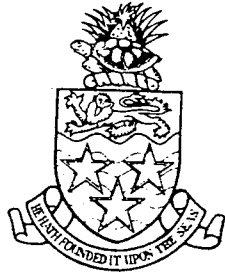

**A LAW TO AMEND THE  
PARLIAMENTARY PENSIONS LAW, 1984**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Parliamentary Pensions (Amendment) Law, 1994.

Amendment to the

2. The Parliamentary Pensions Law, 1984, is amended -

(a) by repealing the definition of "member" in section 2 of the principal Law and substituting the following definition -

"member" means -

(a) in respect of the period between the 1st day of October, 1959 and the 22nd day of August, 1972, an elected or nominated member of the Legislative Assembly; and

(b) in respect of any other period, an elected member of the

Legislative Assembly.";

(b) by repealing the words "1st day of October, 1959" in sections 3(1A)(a) and section 7(1)(b) and substituting the words "22nd day of August, 1972" in each of those provisions; and

(c) by inserting after section 4(1)(a) the following -

"(aa) for persons qualifying both under sections 3(1) and 3(1A) in respect of service as members prior to the 22nd day of August, 1972, at the annual rate specified in section 4 (1)(a); and".

Passed by the Legislative Assembly the 4th day of March, 1994.
