THE PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1995

The Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by subsections (2) and (3) of section 3 of the Pensions Law, makes the following Regulations –

Title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) Regulations 1995.

Amendment of the Pensions Regulations

- 2. (1) The Pensions Regulations, contained in the First Schedule to the Pensions Law, are amended as specified in paragraphs (2) and (3) below.
- (2) Regulation 27 (1) of the Pensions Regulations is amended by revoking the words "31st December 1994" and substituting the words "15th February 1995".
- (3) Regulation 27 (3)(b)(ii) of the Pensions Regulations is amended by revoking the words "two affidavits" and substituting the words "one affidavit".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Pensions Regulations which are contained in the First Schedule to the Pensions Law. The amendment is to the application procedure for the recently announced *ex gratia* allowances to former civil servants. The deadline for applications has been extended until 15th February 1995 and an application now needs to be supported by only one affidavit. This change will allow applications received by 15th February with only one affidavit to be considered, including applications already made at the date these Regulations are Gazetted where the applicant was only able to provide one affidavit.
