A LAW TO AMEND THE POLICE LAW (2014 REVISION); TO MAKE PROVISION FOR REGULATIONS TO BE MADE TO PERMIT THE SHARING OF INFORMATION WITH OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT OR REGULATORY AGENCIES AS REQUIRED FOR COMPLIANCE WITH INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS RELATING TO THE PREVENTION OF MONEY LAUNDERING, TERRORIST FINANCING AND PROLIFERATION FINANCING; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Law, 2016.
- 2. The Police Law (2014 Revision) is amended in section 146 as follows -
 - (a) by renumbering section 146 as section 146(1); and
 - (b) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection -

"(2) Further to subsection (1), the Cabinet may make Regulations for the provision of information to another law enforcement or regulatory agency, whether local or international which, notwithstanding the provisions of any other Law, shall provide for the conduct of, or provision of assistance with, a criminal investigation, as may be required for compliance with
