## THE POLICE LAW [Law 5 of 1979]

### THE POLICE [AMENDMENT] REGULATIONS, 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 84 of the Police Law, the following Regulations are hereby made.

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Regulations, 1980, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1980.

Amendment of regulation 4 of the Police Regulations, 1976. 2. Regulation 4 of the Police Regulations, 1976, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations, is hereby amended by adding, immediately following the word "second" where it appears therein, the words "and third".

Revocation and replacement of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations.

3. The First Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new Schedule:—
