LAW, 1979
(Law 8 of 1979)

Date of Operation: Notice of Non-disallowance published in Gazette of by an attorney.

Cap. 156.

This section does not apply to functions which the donor has as a trustee or personal representative or as a tenant for life within the meaning of the Settled Land Law or to the power to dispose of any interest in immovable property unless such interest is specifically described and the powers with reference thereto are specifically ascertained in the instrument.

Section 28 of the Trusts Law (R) repealed with saving.

9. Subject to subsection (8) of section 7, section 28 of the Trusts Law (Revised) is hereby repealed.

Repeal of Cap. 24.

10. The Conveyancing Law is hereby repealed.

Saving of section 113 of the Registered Land Law (R).

This Law has no application to powers of attorney made under the provisions of section 113 of the Registered Land Law (Revised).
