A LAW TO AMEND THE PROCEEDS OF CRIME LAW (2014 REVISION); TO INCLUDE THE CHIEF OFFICER IN THE MINISTRY RESPONSIBLE FOR FINANCIAL SERVICES OR THE CHIEF OFFICER'S DESIGNATE AS A MEMBER OF THE ANTI-MONEY LAUNDERING STEERING GROUP; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Proceeds of Crime (Amendment) Law, 2015.
- Short title
- 2. The Proceeds of Crime Law (2014 Revision) is amended in section 5(1) by repealing paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph -
 - "(b) the Chief Officer in the Ministry responsible for Financial Services or the Chief Officer's designate;".
