**A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC RECORDER LAW (1996 REVISION)
TO RAISE THE FEES FOR RECORDING DOCUMENTS, TAKING
COPIES OF DOCUMENTS AND SEARCHES; AND FOR INCIDENTAL
AND CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Recorder (Amendment) Law, 2006 and shall come into force on 1st July, 2006. Short title and commencement
2. The Public Recorder Law (1996 Revision), hereinafter called the principal Law, is amended in section 4 (2) (b)-
 - (a) by deleting the words “twenty dollars” and substituting the words “twenty-five dollars”;
 - (b) by deleting the words “five dollars” and substituting the words “ten dollars”.Amendment of section 4- documents for recording
3. The principal Law is amended in section 5 (2) by deleting the words “five dollars” and substituting the words “twenty-five dollars”. Amendment of section 5- copies of documents
4. The principal Law is amended in section 6 by deleting the words “one dollar” and substituting the words “five dollars”. Amendment of section 6 - search
