**A LAW TO AMEND THE PUBLIC RECORDER LAW (2007 REVISION)
SO AS TO INCREASE CERTAIN FEES; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND
CONNECTED PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Public Recorder (Amendment) Law, 2009. Short title

2. The Public Recorder Law (2007 Revision), in this Law referred to as the “principal Law”, is amended in section 4(2) by repealing paragraph (b) and substituting the following paragraph - Amendment of section 4 of the Public Recorder Law (2007 Revision) - documents for recording

“(b) there is paid to him in respect of a document containing one or more pages, a fee of one hundred dollars.”.

3. The principal Law is amended in section 5 by repealing subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection - Amendment of section 5 - copies of documents

“ (2) The fee payable for a copy of a document containing one or more pages is fifty dollars with an additional fee of fifty dollars being payable in respect of each copy certified by the Public Recorder.”.
