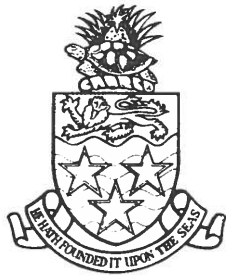

## THE ROADS LAW (REVISED)

### THE ROADS (ROAD NAMES AND PROPERTY NUMBERS) REGULATIONS, 1996

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5 of the Roads Law (Revised), the Governor hereby makes the following Regulations :

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Roads (Road Names and Property Numbers) Regulations, 1996.
2. There is established a Committee known as the Street Addressing Committee.
3. (1) The Committee consists of
  - (a) Chief Surveyor, Chairman;
  - (b) Chief Engineer of Public Works or his assignee;
  - (c) Director of the Planning Department or his assignee;
  - (d) Director of Health or his assignee;
  - (e) an officer of the Computer Services Department appointed by the Computer Services Manager;
  - (f) an officer of the Lands and Survey Department appointed by the Chief Surveyor.
- (2) The Committee shall be deemed to be properly constituted notwithstanding that there is a vacancy in the office of the Chairman or any other member.
4. (1) The meetings of the Committee are to be held at such places and times and on such days as the Chairman determines and at least 3 days' notice shall be given to members of all

meetings of the Committee.

(2) The agenda of each meeting shall be sent to all members of the Committee, and minutes of each meeting shall be kept by a person appointed by the Committee for the purpose. Minutes of each meeting shall be confirmed by the Committee at the following meeting and signed by the Chairman or other person presiding at that meeting.

(3) Four members constitute a quorum.

(4) At any meeting of the Committee in the absence of the Chairman the members present shall elect one of their members to preside at that meeting as Chairman.

(5) Any question or matter to be determined by the Committee at any meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes of the members present and voting on that question or matter; and in the event of an equal division of votes the Chairman of the meeting may give a second or casting vote.

(6) The Committee may appoint other public officers to assist it in the performance of its functions.

5. The Governor as Highway Authority, in accordance with the powers conferred on him by section 5(3) of the Roads Law, delegates to the Committee the functions of naming public roads and numbering plots.

6. In exercising any of the functions specified in paragraph 5 the Committee shall act in accordance with any directions given by the Governor in respect of such functions.

7. The Committee shall provide the Governor in Council with the names of roads and the names shall be approved by the Governor in Council and thereafter published in the Official Gazette.
