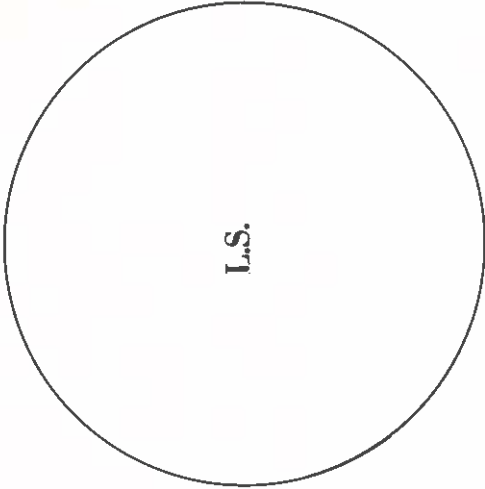

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The purpose of this Law is to increase the stamp duty payable on "Attested Copies, Certified Copies, Counterparts and Duplicates" from 50 cents to 2 dollars and to introduce a new head of duty entitled "Certifications".

A LAW to amend the Stamp Duty Law, 1973 (Law No. 5 of 1973).

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

| 1. This Law may be cited as the Stamp Duty (Amendment) Law, 1977. | |
| 2. The Schedule to the Stamp Duty Law, 1973 is hereby amended — | |
| | (a) by the insertion of a new head of charge to stamp duty between the heads "BOND" and "CHARGE" as follows — |
| | "CERTIFICATIONS given under the hand of the Governor or any other public officer not holding a post in the judicature verifying or confirming the authenticity, or correctness or accuracy of any duplicate or copy, of any instrument which certifications are not otherwise chargeable to duty or attract any official fee or payment under this or any other law \$2.00" |
| | (b) by deleting the figures and words "50 cents" appearing in the head of charge "ATTESTED COPIES, CERTIFIED COPIES, COUNTERPARTS AND DUPLICATES" at the end thereof and substituting the symbol and figure "\$2.00". |
