## A LAW TO APPROPRIATE CERTAIN ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2005

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (July 2004 to June Short title 2005) Law, 2005.
- 2. The Governor in Cabinet may incur executive expenses, acquire executive assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing for the financial year ending 30 June 2005 in the amount and for the respective purposes set forth in the Schedule.
