**A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADE AND BUSINESS LICENSING LAW
(1999 REVISION)**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Trade and Business Licensing (Amendment) Law, 2000. Short title
2. Section 18 of the Trade and Business Licensing Law (1999 Revision), is amended in subsection (1) by- Amendment of section 18 of the principal law
 - (a) the deletion of the full stop at the end of paragraph (d) and the substitution therefor of a comma; and
 - (b) the addition, on the next line immediately thereafter, of the words “which notice of appeal shall be accompanied by a non-refundable processing fee of one hundred dollars.”.
3. The principal law is amended by the addition, immediately following section 29, of the following new section- Addition of new section to the principal law

“Powers of immigration
officers

30. Any immigration officer appointed under section 3 of the Immigration Law (2000 Revision) shall have authority and power to carry out such instructions as may be given by the Board in relation to this Law and may enforce, on behalf of the Board, any powers granted by this Law or the regulations.”.
