THE TRADE AND BUSINESS LICENSING ORDER (NO.2) 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Trade and Business Licensing Law (2002 Revision), the Governor in Council makes the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade and Business Licensing Order (No.2) 2002. Citation

2. The Trade and Business Licensing Law (2002 Revision) is amended in the Schedule - Amendment of the
Schedule to the Trade
and Business Licensing
Law (2002 Revision) -
fees

(a) by inserting before the word "firm" where it first appears the following-

"computer specialist" means a person (whether industry certified or not) involved in the development, assembly, building, maintenance or repair of computer equipment and computer programmes or similar work relating to computers;";

(b) by inserting the following definition in its appropriate alphabetical order -

" other professional" means -

(a) a person who engages in a trade or business (such as an accountant, actuary, architect, engineer, lawyer, statistician and surveyor) which is different from his employer's main trade or business; and

(b) who provides chargeable services in his trade or business to his employer's customers"; and

(c) in item 4, by repealing the words " or Computer Specialist" and by inserting the following item after item 6-

"6A. Computer specialist \$1500".
