A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADE UNION LAW (1998 REVISION) TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR AN AUDITOR TO BE APPROVED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED PURPOSES

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Trade Union (Amendment) Law, 2018. Short title
2. The Trade Union Law (1998 Revision) is amended as follows - Amendment of the Trade Union Law (1998 Revision) - substitution of "Cabinet" for "Governor" and "Governor in Council"
 - (a) by deleting the word "Governor" wherever this word appears; and
 - (b) by deleting the words "Governor in Council" wherever these words appear,and substituting the word "Cabinet".
3. The Trade Union Law (1998 Revision) is amended in section 21(1)(c) by deleting the words "approved by the Governor for the purpose" and substituting Amendment of section 21 of the Trade Union Law (1998 Revision) - statement of accounts and audit certificate to be transmitted to Registrar

the words “registered and licensed under the Accountants Law, 2016.”.
