**A LAW TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC LAW (2003 REVISION) FOR THE
PURPOSE OF MAKING PROVISION FOR THE LICENSING OF
OVERSIZE VEHICLES; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR INCIDENTAL
AND CONNECTED MATTERS**

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) Law, 2010.
2. The Traffic Law (2003 Revision) is amended in section 2 by deleting the definition of the words “oversize truck” and substituting the following definition -

Short title

Amendment of section 2
of the Traffic Law (2003
Revision) - definitions

““oversize vehicle” means a vehicle in any of the following categories -

- (a) having an overall width in excess of eight feet and six inches;
- (b) having an overall travelling height in excess of fourteen feet;
- (c) having a maximum gross weight in excess of sixty-six thousand pounds; and
- (d) towing a trailer the length of which exceeds forty-five feet;”.
