## THE TRAFFIC (PRESCRIPTION OF MEASURING DEVICE) ORDER, 1990.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 62(2)(a) and section 77(h) of the Traffic Law (Revised), the following Order is hereby made -

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as The Traffic (Prescription of Measuring Device) Order, 1990.

Prescription of Measuring Device.

2. The Intoxilyzer 5000 manufactured by CMI Inc. a subsidiary of MPD Incorporated in Owensboro, Kentucky in the United States of America, is hereby prescribed as an alcohol-in-breath measuring device for the purposes of section 62 of the Traffic Law (Revised).
