1. This order may be cited as the Traffic (Prescription of Measuring Devices) Order (1999 Revision). Citation
2. The following devices are prescribed as alcohol-in-breath measuring devices for the purposes of section 62 - Prescription of measuring devices
  - (a) the Intoxilyzer manufactured by CMI Incorporated, Minturn, Colorado in the United States of America; and
  - (b) the Intoxilyzer 5000 manufactured by CMI Incorporated, a subsidiary of MPD Incorporated in Owensboro, Kentucky in the United States of America.
