THE TRAFFIC (RADAR SPEEDOMETER) REGULATIONS, 2001

In accordance with the powers conferred by section 96 of the Traffic Law (2001 Revision) the Governor makes the following regulations-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Radar Speedometer) Regulations, 2001. Citation
2. For the purposes of section 96 of the Traffic Law (2001 Revision) a device designed or adapted for recording a measurement of the speed of a motor vehicle activated by means of a microwave beam or beams and approved from time to time by the Commissioner shall be used for the purpose of detecting speeds of vehicles on the road. Radar speedometer
3. The Traffic (Radar Equipment) Regulations (1999 Revision) are repealed. Repeal of the Traffic
