THE TRAFFIC LAW. (No. 16 of 1973)

THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by virtue of sections 51, 17 and 82 of the Traffic Law, the following Regulations are hereby made.

Short title and commencement 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Regulations, and shall come into force in whole or in part on a day to be appointed by the Governor by Government Notice published in the Islands.

Interpretation. In these Regulations —
 "Law" means the Traffic Law;
 "section" means a section of the Law; and section 2 applies.

Forms. Schedule. 3. Forms required by the Law to be prescribed are set forth in the schedule.

Licence plates, bicycle tags and coupons, (Section 11 (2), (iii) and (iv).)

4. (1) The official vehicles used by the Governor in person shall carry, in lieu of a licence plate a crown or the coat of arms of the Islands.

(2) The licence plates, bicycle tags and coupons required by sub-paragraphs (iii) and (iv) of section 11 to be prescribed are prescribed in the schedule.

Vehicle testing, places and times, (Section 24(1)). 5. Driving and vehicle testing shall normally be carried out between the hours of 0830 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays other than public holidays at the Police Station, George Town and the Post Office, Cayman Brac and at such other times and places as the Commissioner may by public notice appoint.

Display of plates, tags and coupons, (Section 26 (D. L.)

6. (1) For the purposes of subsection (1) of section 26, the coupon shall be displayed at all times on the side of the front windshield furtherest from the steering wheel or, where no such windshield is fitted to the vehicle, in the area where the windshield would or ordinarily be located, save that, in the case of trailers, the coupon shall be displayed on the near side back of the trailer; the licence plates or trade plates as the case may be shall be displayed at the front and rear of the vehicle, or at the rear only in the case of a trailer, so that the plate shall be parallel with the ground and not

more than 36 inches and not less than 8 inches clear of the ground.

- (2) For the purpose of subsection (2) of section 26, the bicycle tag shall be attached to a hub, the handle bars or under the saddle of the bicycle.
- (3) Coupons, plates and tags required to be displayed must be visible and readable at all times.

Age qualifications. (Section 32 (a)).

- 7. The age qualifications for drivers of motor vehicles required to be prescribed by paragraph (a) of section 32 are
 - (a) for driving a motor cycle
 do a motor car,
 do a station wagon, or
 do a rent-a-car, 17 years
 (b) do a truck not exceeding
 3 tons capacity 18 do
 (c) do any other vehicle 21 do
 ave that a person of any age, if permitted so to do by the

save that a person of any age, if permitted so to do by the Commissioner, may drive an invalid carriage.

Trade plates and coupons. (Section 28(1).)

8. The dimensions of trade plates required to be prescribed by section 28(1) shall be 6 inches in height and 12 inches or upwards in length with figures 3 inches in height or, in the case of motor cycles and invalid carriages, of such dimensions as may be approved by the Commissioner from time to time.

"L" plates. (Section 40(a)). 9. The "L" plates required to be prescribed by paragraph (a) of section 40 are prescribed in the schedule and shall be prominently displayed on the front and rear of every vehicle when, and only when, such vehicle is being driven by the holder of a provisional licence.

The driving test. (Section 41(3)). 10. The following are the requirements for the purpose of subsection (3) of section 41 for the passing of a driving test

the applicant shall satisfy the examiner that he is capable of driving the class of vehicle in respect of which he is seeking a licence to drive and in particular that he can —

- (a) read in good daylight (with the aid of glasses if worn) a licence plate number fixed to a motor vehicle at a distance of 60 feet;
- (b) start the vehicle from rest smoothly and efficiently and maintain it on an accurate course as directed by the examiner;

- (c) make turns to the right and left with accuracy and without endangering other road users;
- (d) stop the vehicle smoothly and efficiently at various speeds and make emergency stops;
- (e) operate all the controls of the vehicle efficiently and with safety;
- (f) if the vehicle is capable of being reversed, drive and turn it in reverse accurately and smoothly;
- (g) stop and start the vehicle on gradients;
- (h) turn the vehicle completely about by the use of forward and reverse gears within a reasonable compass;
- (i) make such other normal manoeuvres as the examiner shall direct; and that
- (j) he is familiar with the road code and generally with the provisions of the Law, particularly sections 55 to 59; and

the applicant shall be required to pass a written examination to ascertain whether he has the knowledge required of him by paragraph (i) and to answer not less than 80% of the questions correctly.

Photographs of taxi drivers, (Section 43(1)).

11. The form of photograph prescribed for the purpose of subsection (1) of section 43 shall be unmounted and taken full face without a hat and of dimensions not more than $2" \times 1-1/2"$, and not less than $1-1/2" \times 1"$.

Omnibus and taxis (Section 44(2).).

- 12. (a) Every taxi and omnibus shall be plainly designated as such by having the words TAXI or OMNIBUS, as the case may be, painted on the sides or doors of the vehicle and above the centre of the windshield in yellow lettering not less than two and a half and not more than three inches in height on a black or yellow background, and taxis shall at night display at the front above the centre of the windshield the word TAXI electrically illuminated in amber on black or black on amber coloured letters not less than two and a half or more than three inches in height, which illumination may be switched off at times when the taxi is carrying a passenger for hire; omnibuses shall carry such special illumination as the Commissioner may from time to time approve.
- (b) There shall be prominently displayed inside every taxi and omnibus a notice in a form approved by the Commissioner showing
 - (i) the registration number of the vehicle; and
 - (ii) the conditions of hire or use and a fare table.
- (c) The driver of a taxi or omnibus, as the case may be, shall not refuse to accept a passenger for a lawful journey

while the omnibus has a vacant seat or the taxi is plying for hire.

- (d) An omnibus is not obliged to set down or pick up passengers otherwise than at a place designated by the Commissioner as an omnibus stop and marked as such.
 - (e) Every driver in charge of a taxi shall
 - (i) be clean and neat in person and dress;
 - (ii) wear prominently a numeral badge of a design approved by the Commissioner;
 - (iii) refrain from using in his vehicle any radio set other than radio telephone unless he has first obtained the consent of any passenger he may be carrying.
 - (f) Any taxi driver may refuse to carry —
 - (i) any animal;
 - (ii) any item of baggage which cannot conveniently and safely be stowed in his vehicle.
 - (g) No person shall —
 - (i) hire any taxi unless he can pay the legal charge of such hire;
 - (ii) avoid or attempt to avoid payment or any legal charge incurred by him for the hire of any taxi; or
 - (iii) withhold his true name and address from any taxi driver lawfully demanding payment of a legal charge incurred by him for the hire of a taxi, which demand remains unsatisfied.

Rent-a-car firms, (Section 45(1)). 13. The following are the rent-a-car firms required by subsection (1) of section 45 to be prescribed —

Exres. (Section 53(D)(a) F

- 14. (1) All vehicles used on the road other than special vehicles specifically exempted by the Commissioner shall be fitted with pneumatic tyres in sound condition and having a tread depth of at least one millimetre around the circumference of the tyre and across three-quarters of its breadth, including any tyre on a spare wheel carried by the vehicle.
- (2) Radial tyres shall not be mixed with other tyres on the same axle and, if fitted to the front axle, must be fitted all round (spare included).

Brakes (Section 53(1)(d)). 15:2 Every vehicle other than a special vehicle specifically exempted by the Commissioner or a trailer of capacity not exceeding two shipping tons shall have two independent braking systems in good working order, one of which is capable of being operated while the vehicle is stationary, and one of which is capable of bringing the vehicle to a halt within 50 feet when travelling at 25 miles per hour.

Lights. (Section 53(1)(e)).

- 16. (1) No mechanically propelled vehicle other than emergency vehicle shall be equipped with
 - (a) any external light of a colour other than white, red or amber; or
 - (b) any light other than a headlight or headlights which is capable of having its beam moved while the vehicle is in motion; or
 - (c) any light other than headlights, stop lights, emergency lights or trafficators having an output in excess of 7 watts.
 - (2) For the purposes of this Regulation —
 - (a) a headlight is a light carried at the front of a vehicle capable of being dipped to the left when the vehicle is in motion:
 - (b) a sidelight is one of a pair of lights placed on each side of the front of a vehicle:
 - (c) a rearlight is a red light placed at the rear of a vehicle;
 - (d) a stoplight is a red light placed at the rear of a mechanically propelled vehicle which becomes illuminated or the illumination of which becomes intensified when a brake of the vehicle is actuated, so as to be clearly visible by day and by night;
 - (e) a reverse light is a light placed at the rear of a vehicle which becomes illuminated only when the vehicle is engaged in reverse gear;
 - (f) an emergency light is a pulsating red or amber light designed to be used only for the purpose of giving warning of an emergency in connection with the

- vehicle to which it is fitted;
- (g) a reflector is a device for reflecting in red the beam of a light turned in its direction;
- (h) a registration plate light is a light illuminating the rear number plate of a vehicle at night time so as to render it readable at a distance of 30 feet; and
- (i) a trafficator is a pulsating or flashing light placed at each side of a vehicle for the purpose of indicating that such vehicle is about to turn in the direction of the side where such light is made to flash and designed so as to be clearly visible by day as well as by night.
- (3) No red light of any kind shall be displayed at the front of any vehicle.
- (4) No white light of any kind other than a reverse light or a registration plate light shall be located at the rear of any vehicle.
- (5) Subject to regulation 24 no amber light of any kind other than a trafficator or emergency light shall be located or displayed so as to be visible from the rear of any vehicle.
- (6) No external light shall be carried less than eighteen inches or more than four feet above the ground level on any vehicle unless specifically authorized by the Law or any Regulation.
- (7) The following are the minimum lighting requirements for the vehicle to which reference is made
 - (a) bicycles shall have one light fixed in front which may or may not be capable of being dipped to the left, one rear light attached to the off-side rear fork or a reflector visible from the rear, all so devised that the presence and movement of the bicycle shall be clearly visible at night time within a range of 50 yards:
 - (b) motorcycles shall have a headlamp in front and a rear light, reflector, stoplight and registration plate light at the rear;
 - (c) mechanically propelled vehicles other than motorcycles, invalid carriages and special vehicles shall have one pair of sidelights and not less than one or more than two pairs of headlights at the front, two rear lights, two reflectors, two stoplights placed on each side of the vehicle and a registration plate light at the rear and shall have trafficators so placed as to be clearly visible from the front and rear of the vehicle when in operation by night and by day; each pair of lights shall be of equal candle power.
 - (d) special vehicles and invalid carriages shall be

- equipped with such lights as, notwithstanding these Regulations, the Commissioner may specifically require; and
- (e) emergency vehicles shall be equippped with such additional lights as the Commissioner may specifically require and, in addition, may carry a blue rotating light in such a position as to give warning of their presence and of their movements in every direction.

Horns, ctc (Section (SGHI)), 17. Every bicycle shall be equipped with a hand operated bell and every mechanically propelled vehicle shall be equipped with means of giving audible warning of its presence but no mechanically propelled vehicle other than an emergency vehicle shall be equipped with any gong, bell, siren or any device capable of giving two or more different sounds in succession.

Driving interest (Section (Section (Section (T(b))) 18. Every mechanically propelled vehicle shall be equipped with at least one driving mirror so placed that the person driving it shall have a clear view of traffic approaching from his rear.

Silencers etc. (Section 53(2)(c) 3 19. Every vehicle propelled by an internal combustion engine shall be fitted with a silencer or a silencer in combination with a muffler according to its manufacturer's standard design and no person shall make modification to such silencer or muffler so as in any way to increase the noise of escaping exhaust gas. Such silencers and mufflers shall be maintained in a leak proof condition and in sound mechanical order.

Unsafe loading. (Section 53(5)(d) 1.

20. Where any vehicle carrying goods or passengers appears to be loaded in such a way as to be liable to cause a nuisance or danger to any person a constable in uniform may require the driver thereof to take such lawful steps as shall remove the risk of such nuisance or danger occurring and such driver shall comply with such requirement which may include the use of tailgates, coverings and devices for the prevention of spillage.

Speedometer, (Section 53(6)). 21. Every mechanically propelled vehicle capable of travelling under its own power at a speed in excess of fifteen miles per hour shall be fitted with a speedomater clearly visible to the driver and indicating to him the rate of travel of the vehicle in miles or kilometers per hour up to its maximum designed speed with an accuracy of not less than ninety per cent.

Speed limits. (Section 63(1)). (Section 77(c)).

- 22. A maximum speed of 25 miles per hour is prescribed by virtue of paragraph (c) of section 77 in respect of all vehicles driven in the following places
 - (a) The town of West Bay including all that area to the North of Grid Line 214220m N.
 - (b) The Town of George Town including all that area:-bounded on the north by the Grid Line 2135000m N and on the east by the Grid Line 463000m E and on the West and South by the sea.
 - (c) The town of Savannah including all that portion of the main road passing through Savannah between the Grid Lines 467660m E and 469040m E.
 - (d) The Town of Bodden Town including all that part of the main road passing through Bodden Town between the Grid Lines 472350m E and 475050m E.
 - (e) The Town of East End including all that portion of the main road passing through East End between the Grid Lines 487440m E and 2136120m N.
 - (f) The town of North Side including all those portions of road between the Grid Lines 2138680m N and to the west where the road crosses Grid Lines 476300m E.
 - (g) The town of Breakers including that portion of the road passing through Breakers between the Grid Lines 478480m E and 479500m E.

- (h) The whole of Little Cayman and the following parts of Cayman Brac.
 - (1) From the Airport to a point a quarter of a mile east of Faith Hospital.
 - (2) From a point one quarter of a mile west of the High School to a point one quarter of a mile east thereof.
 - (3) From a point one quarter of a mile west of Tibbetts turn, to the end of the public road at Spot Bay.
- (i) Those parts of roads specifically marked by prescribed 25 MPH speed limit signs.
- 23. The following are prescribed radar speed meters for the purposes of subsection (3) of section 63(2)—

Prescribed radar speed meters. (Section 63(2)).

- (a) the Marconi portable electronic traffic analyser;
- (b) the Electro-matic radar speed meter manufactured by the Automatic Signal Division of the Laboratory for Electronics, Norwalk, Conn., U.S.A.

Overhanging loads (Section 11)

- 24. Every vehicle carrying an overhanging load shall mark such load in the following manner
 - (a) by day with a red flag at least one foot by one foot in size at each point where such load projects outside the profile of the vehicle;
 - (b) by night with a white light to the front, a red light to the rear and an amber light to the sides at each point where such load projects beyond the profile of the vehicle.

Where the overhanging load projects beyond three feet over either side of the vehicle, such vehicle shall not move unless accompanied by a police escort at such time and date as the Commissioner shall order after he has been requested so to do by not less than 48 hours notice in writing.

Governor may disapprove of acces sories (Section 77(b))

- 25. The Governor may, on the advice of the Commissioner, disapprove of any crash helmet, driving mirror, windscreen wiper, horn, light, speedometer or other piece of equipment for use on a vehicle if it appears that such piece of equipment is
 - (a) unsafe:
 - (b) likely to be a nuisance to the public; or
 - (c) inadequate for the purpose for which it appears to be intended:

and such disapproved piece of equipment shall not be used for, carrier in any vehicle, neither shall it be imported into or sold in the Islands for use with a vehicle.

(2) Every vehicle imported into or used in the Islands which would otherwise be likely to cause interference with radio reception by the public shall be equipped with effective radio interference suppressors.

Tow ropes (Section ==O) k

- 26. Where any driver of a vehicle uses a tow rope for the purpose of towing another vehicle such tow rope
 - (a) shall not exceed 15 feet in length; and
 - (b) shall be marked with pieces of red cloth or by some other means so as to render it clearly visible to other road users.

27. The following fees are prescribed in connection with inspection, registration and licensing under the Law.






