1. These regulations may be cited as the Traffic Ticket Regulations (1999 Revision). Citation
2. (1) For the purposes of section 79, the prescribed forms of traffic tickets are the forms set out in the First Schedule hereto. Traffic tickets and fines

(2) For the purposes of section 79, the prescribed fines for the offences referred to in that section are the fines in the last column of the table in the Second Schedule hereto specified respectively for the offences listed in the first column of that table.
