

A LAW TO AMEND THE TRAVEL (DEPARTURE TAX AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FEE) LAW (2002 REVISION) IN ORDER TO EXEMPT IN TRANSIT TRAVELLERS FROM TAXES AND FEES UNDER THE LAW; AND FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED **PURPOSES**

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

This Law may be cited as the Travel (Departure Tax and Environmental Short title Protection Fee) (Amendment) Law, 2002.

- The Travel (Departure Tax and Environmental Protection Fee) Law (2002) Revision) is amended in section 2 as follows-
 - (a) by inserting the following definition in its appropriate alphabetical order-

"in transit" in relation to a traveller on an aircraft, means a person who is passing through the Islands for a period of less than 24 hours en route to another jurisdiction; and

- (b) in the definition "traveller" by inserting the following new paragraph-
 - "(d) a person who is in transit in the Islands.".

- 3. The Travel (Departure Tax and Environmental Protection Fee) Law (2002 Revision) is amended in section 6 as follows-
 - (a) in subsection (1), by repealing the word "passenger" and substituting the words "traveller and tourist"; and
 - (b) in subsection (2), by repealing the word "passenger" and substituting the word "tourist".
