A LAW TO AMEND THE TRUSTS LAW, 1967 (Law 6 of 1967)

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Trusts (Amendment) Law, 1971 and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Islands.

Short title and commencement.

2. Section 70 of the Trusts Law, 1967 is hereby amended by deleting the sign and figures "£50" occurring in the last line thereof and substituting therefor the the sign and figures "\$200".

Sec. 70 of Law 6 of 1967 amended.

3. The Trasts (Amendment) Law, 1970 is hereby repealed retrospectively from the 8th day of January 1971.
