A LAW TO AMEND THE UNIVERSITY COLLEGE LAW (2005 REVISION) AS A CONSEQUENCE OF THE CREATION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICE OF MINISTER CHARGED WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR FINANCE; AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR INCIDENTAL AND CONNECTED MATTERS

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the University College (Amendment) Law, 2010. Short

2. The University College Law (2005 Revision), in this Law referred to as the "principal Law", is amended in section 2 by inserting, after the definition of the word "Minister", the following definition -

" "Minister of Finance" means the Member of Cabinet responsible for finance;".

3. The principal Law is amended in section 3(3) by repealing paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph -

"(a) a representative of the Minister of Finance;".

The principal Law is amended in sections 6, 10(2) and (3), 11(1), (2) and (5) and 18(1) by deleting the words "Financial Secretary" wherever they appear and substituting the words "Minister of Finance".
