THE WATER AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2007

The Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 70 of the Water Authority Law (1996 Revision) makes the following Regulations:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Water Authority (Amendment) Regulations, 2007.

Citation and commencement

- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on 1st July, 2007.
- 2. The Water Authority Regulations (1999 Revision) are amended in regulation 49 by repealing subregulation (1) and substituting the following:

Amendment of regulation 49 of the Water Authority Regulations (1999 Revision) – water charges

- "(1) The charges to be paid to the Authority for the supply of desalinated water via the public water supply system are a monthly charge in accordance with the following categories of consumer or user-
 - (a) Domestic \$4.01 per cubic metre for the first twelve cubic metres and \$5.10 for each cubic metre thereafter, subject to a minimum charge of \$16.04;
 - (b) Truckers \$4.01 per cubic metre for the first twelve cubic metres and \$4.25 for each cubic metre thereafter;
 - c) Water Company \$4.81 per cubic metre for the first twelve cubic metres and \$5.10 for each cubic metre thereafter;
 - (d) Commercial and \$4.81 per cubic metre for the first twelve cubic metres and \$5.10 for each cubic metre thereafter, subject to a minimum charge of \$19.24;

(e) Municipal (Public Authority)

\$4.35 per cubic metre for the first twelve cubic metres and \$4.61 for each cubic metre thereafter, subject to a minimum charge of \$17.40;

(f) Water sold in Cayman Brac to all categories of users through the piped water distribution system \$5.60 per cubic metre, subject to a minimum charge of \$22.40;

(g) Water sold in \$7.00 per cubic metre.".
