THE FIREARMS LAW, 1964 THE FIREARMS REGULATIONS, 1965

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Administrator by ection 39 subsection (1) of the Firearms Law, 1964, the following legulations are hereby made with the advice of the Executive council.

- l. These Regulations may be cited as the Firearms (Forms) Reguations, 1965.
- !. These Regulations shall apply -
 - (a) to any application for a Firearm Export Permit or a Firearm I mport Permit or a Firearm User's (General) Licence or a Firearm User's (Restricted) Licence or a Firearm User's (Special) Permit or a Firearm Disposal Permit; or
 - (b) to any licence or permit granted pursuant to such application.
- 3. Every application for any licence or permit to which these Regulations apply shall $\!\!\!$
 - (a) be in the appropriate form specified in the Schedule to these Regulations; and
 - (b) contain the particulars specified in such form.
- 4. Every licence or permit granted pursuant to the provisions of these Regulations shall -
 - (a) be in the appropriate form specified in the Schedule to these Regulations; and
 - (b) contain the particulars specified in such form.
- 5. Every applicant for a Firearm User's (Special) Permit shall forward with his application two small unmounted photographs approximately 2" x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " of himself, and on the back of one such photograph a certificate signed by the applicant to the effect that the photograph is a true likeness.
- 6. No person shall be issued with a-
 - (i) Firearm User's (General) Licence; or
 - (ii) Firearm User's (Restricted) Licence; or
 - (iii) Firearm User's (Special) Permit,

unless -

- (a) in the case of a shot gun the applicant has attained the age of 17 years;
- b) in the case of an air rifle the applicant has attained the age of 12 years;
- (c) in respect of all other types of firearms the applicant has attained the age of 21 years.
- 7. Every aggrieved party shall give notice of appeal on the prescribed form which shall be accompanied by a fee of One Pound and this fee shall be refunded to the appellant if the appeal is successful.

- 19 (a) A Firearm Import Permit authorising the holder thereof during such period as may be specified in the Permit to import into the Cayman Islands from such sources as may be specified.
- 19 (e) a Firearm User's (General Licence) authorising the holder thereof, subject to the provisions of Section 17 of the Firearms Law, to be in possession of the firearm specified in such licence anywhere in the Cay nan Islands.
- 19 (f) a Firearm User's (Restricted) Licence authorising the holder thereof, subject to the provisions of Section 17 of Firearms Law, to be in possession of the firearm specified in such Licence-
 - (i) upon any premises owned or occupied by the holder thereof and such portion of any public road as passes through any such premises; and
 - (ii) upon such other premises as may be specified in the Licence and such portion of any public road as ρasses through any premises so specified.
- 19 (g) a Firearm User's (Special) Permit authorising the holder thereof to be in possession of the firearm specified in such Permit within any area so specified to which the provisions; of Section 17 of the Firearms Law apply upon such occasions as may be so specified.
- N.B. Applicants must use a separate application form for each weapon requiring permit or licence.
