## THE MEDICAL SERVICE FEES REGULATIONS, 1965

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator ith the approval of the Legislative Assembly by section 10 f the Medical Service Law, 1953, the following Regulations re hereby made.

These Regulations may be cited as the Medical Service ees Fegulations, 1965, and shall come into operation on a ay to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice ublished in the Cayman Islands.

Short title and commencement.

The following fees shall be payable in respect of any treatent accommodation, amenities, facilities, services or materuls provided by or through the Government of the Islands.
