THE MEDICAL SERVICE FEES REGULATIONS, 1965

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator with the approval of the Legislative Assembly by section 10 of the Medical Service Law, 1953, the following Regulations are hereby made.

These Regulations may be cited as the Medical Service Fees Regulations, 1965, and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

The following fees shall be payable in respect of any treatment, accommodation, amenities, facilities, services or materials provided by or through the Government of the Islands.
