The Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Regulations, 1965

. In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator in Council by section 31 of the Motor Vehicles Law, 1961, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Regulations, 1965, and shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Administrator by Government Notice published in the Cayman Islands.

. Form C in the Schedule to the Motor Vehicles Regulations, 1961, is hereby deleted and the following new form substituted therefor -

MOTOR VEHICLE LAW 1961

The coupon to be printed on white paper with all inscriptions in black except the last two digits of the year of effect to be overprinted in bold print as indicated by the outline "65" on the specimen in such a manner as not to obscure the printed words or to make illegible the particulars entered on the coupon. The coupon to be 3" in diameter with four triangular sections and a section 1" wide running horizontally through the centre of the coupon. The triangular sections shall represent the four quarters of the year for which the prescribed tax is paid for licensing the vehicle and shall be in colour commencing from the first quarter section, i.e. if the vehicle is licensed for half year the two upper sections will be in colour.

Three colours to be used, green, yellow and blue, one each year alternately."
