The Diplomatic Agent (Immunity from
Legal Process) Law, 1964

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1—This Law may be cited as the Diplomatic Agent (Immunity from Legal Process) Law, 1964. Short title.

2 —In this Law —

“Diplomatic Agent” means the Head of a Mission or a member of the Diplomatic staff of a Mission.

Interpretation.

3—Where a diplomatic agent is passing through, either to take up or to return to his post, or is otherwise temporarily resident in, any of the Cayman Islands, he shall be accorded such immunity from legal process or Immunity from legal process.

other restraint upon his person prescribed by Law as shall ensure his transit or return unhindered.

Immunity to extend to members of diplomatic agent.

4—The preceding section shall apply expressly to the members of the family of the diplomatic agent who are accompanying the diplomatic agent or travelling separately either to join him or to return to their own country.
