A LAW to Amend the Customs Consolidation Law, 1897.

Enacted by the legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1—This Law may be cited as the Customs Consolidation (Amendment) (No. 2) Law, 1964, and shall be read and construed as one with the Customs Consolidation Law, 1897 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law) and all amendments thereto and shall come into operation on a day to be published by the Administrator by Government Notice.
