A LAW to Amend the Bicycles (Control) Law, 1963

()

Enacted by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1— This Law may be cited as the Bicycles (Control) (Amendment) Law, 1965, and shall be read and construed as one with the Bicycles (Control) Law, 1963, hereinafter referred to as the principal Law, and all amendments thereto, and shall come into operation on a day to be published by the Administrator by Government Notice.

2— Section 13 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows -

2 (No. 20) *The Bicycles (Control) (Amendment) Law, 1965.*

(1) by inserting the figure “(1)” after the figure (13) in line one of this section;

(2) by adding subsection (2) as follows -

“(2) Any person contravening the provisions of the preceding subsection shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One Pound and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding fourteen days or to both such fine and imprisonment.”.
